



Barbarella: Modern Times Rock 'n' Roll!

Nasty, hard, honest. Four men from Nijmegen. The song always in sight. No bullshit: Modern Times Rock 'n' Roll.

Barbarella originated in 2005. In 2008 debut album Neon City was released and distributed via Freebird Records. It got airplay on Dutch national radiostation 3FM. 3voor12 calls the album 'ruler tight and greasy as mud'. Barbarella plays at festivals like de Zwarte Cross, de Affaire, Appelpop and supports Fu Manchu, Truckfighters and Peter Pan Speedrock.

In 2010, a new single I am the Wolf was released. Guido Aalbers (Miss Montreal, Bertolf, Agua de Annique) mixes the digital-only single. Barbarella also provides a track for the 'Keizersnede' compilation CD: When The Shit Hits the Fan.

Influences

The influence of '60s and '70s hard rock is evident. Just like punk, grunge and stoner rock. Think Motorspycho, Foo Fighters, Deep Purple, Smashing Pumpkins. To comprise the definition of Barbarella: groovy riffs, psychedelic and hard rock packed into tight song structures. The music of Barbarella is here and now: Modern Times Rock 'n' Roll.

Members

In 2005, drummer Peter Onstein, bassist Joost Reijnders and guitarist Remco Verweij start a stoner rock band. Primarily instrumental, but soon they find lead singer Jody Peters, who also plays guitar. In December 2008 Remco leaves Barbarella. Fortunately Jaap Lagerweij (The Mellotones) strengthened the band in February 2009.

Cool!

With a bag full of heavy rock Barbarella hits the road. The band gained quite a following and got some great reviews while touring the clubs in the Netherlands. Debut CD 'Neon City' is very well received, 'ruler tight and greasy as mud' (3voor12), 'cool!' (Radio Mortale). Barbarella also got some rave live reviews: effective rocking songs, energetic, a delight for the ear, rock as it should be.
